AGREEMENT

between

Embassy of Hungary in Tallinn, Liszt Institute – Hungarian Cultural Center in Tallinn and

The Estonian Literary Museum (Tartu, Estonia)

The Embassy of Hungary in Tallinn and the Liszt Institute – Hungarian Cultural Center Tallinn, hereinafter referred to as 'Hungarian Side', represented by H.E. Ambassador Pál András and Director János Tischler, on the one hand, and The Estonian Literary Museum, hereinafter referred to as 'ELM', represented by Acting Director Merike Kiipus, on the other hand, both hereinafter referred to as 'Parties', have concluded the following Agreement, hereinafter referred to as 'Agreement':

1. Purpose of the Agreement

The **Parties** jointly republish the poem 'Sangar János' ("János vitéz") by Sándor Petőfi in Estonian, translated by Ellen Niit, on the occasion of the 200th anniversary of the poet's birth. The publication of the volume is scheduled for May 2023. The **Hungarian Side** signs a separate contract with Szilárd Tóth, responsible for the editing and design works of the volume.

2. The Parties shall cooperate during the republication in the following areas:

- 2.1. The ELM provides the ISBN number, the Hungarian Side the ISSN number.
- 2.2. Joint proof-reading of the volume.
- 2.3. The volume is edited by Szilárd Tóth.
- 2.4. The volume is the next in the 'Ungari taskuraamat' series published by the **Hungarian Side.**
- 2.5. The volume is published with a foreword by Szilárd Tóth.
- 2.6. The volume is planned to be published with 10-12 illustrations.
- 2.7. Cover design by Szilárd Tóth.
- 2.8. Planned circulation: 500 copies (400 for the **Hungarian Side**, 100 for the **ELM**).
- 2.9. The book's editorial page.
- 2.10. The **Parties** jointly agree to use the logo of the Petőfi Bicentenary Year, provided by the **Hungarian Side**, during the publishing and promotion of the poem.

3. Funding

The financial implications of the publication of the volume will be the subject of a separate contract in 2023.

4. Deadlines

- 4.1. Deadline for preparing the manuscript: November 15, 2022 (Szilárd Tóth).
- 4.2. Completion of the editing of the manuscript: 20 December 2022 (Szilárd Tóth).
- 4.3. Manuscript goes to print: March 2023 (Hungarian Side).
- 4.4. Publication of the volume: May 2023.

5. Other terms and conditions

- 5.1. The **Parties** shall settle all arising disputes amicably.
- 5.2. The **Agreement** is made in English, in two identical copies.
- 5.3. Coordinators whose role is to oversee the implementation of the Agreement shall be on the one hand editor of the book Szilárd Tóth and János Tischler, director of the Liszt Institute – Hungarian Cultural Center Tallinn for the **Hungarian Side**, and on the other hand Mare Kõiva, PhD (folkloristics), Head of the Department of Folkloristics, leading research fellow and the head of the Centre of Excellence in Estonian Studies, for the ELM.

6. Further cooperation

The cooperation between the Parties will continue in 2023, the second year of the Petőfi Bicentenary Year, with the publication of selected poems of Sándor Petőfi in Estonian, which will be regulated by a new contract.
