COOPERATION AGREEMENT

This agreement is concluded on April 18, 2023 in Krakow, between:

JESUIT UNIVERSITY IGNATIANUM IN KRAKOW - Ul. Mikolaja Kopernika 26, 31-501, Krakow, Poland

and

ESTONIAN LITERARY MUSEUM - 42 Vanemuise St., 51003, Tartu, Estonia

Jesuit University Ignatianum in Krakow, represented by Rector Dr. hab. Tomasz Homa, Prof. AIK SJ, and the **Estonian Literary Museum**, represented by Director Dr. Piret Voolaid, hereinafter the Parties, considering the development of international cooperation in the field of education, science and technology to be of mutual advantage for both institutions, agree on the following:

Article 1

Based on equality and mutual interests, the Parties shall develop the following forms of cooperation:

- a. exchange of students at all levels (undergraduate, master and post-graduate programs);
- b. mobility of lecturers and researchers;
- c. carrying out joint research and educational projects;
- d. exchange of information, teaching materials and scientific publications;
- e. organizing conferences, seminars, workshops and courses; joint publications.

Article 2

The financial conditions of any activity within the framework of this agreement shall be determined in the additional documents on the basis of available financial resources. It is possible to involve other organizations and funds to finance the cooperation.

Article 3

This agreement does not exclude other forms of cooperation that can be proposed for discussion by either of the Parties. The Parties shall be notified in written form of all changes in the agreement. All changes in the agreement shall be made in written form and are to be signed by both Parties.

Article 4

This agreement comes into force on the date of its signing by the corresponding authorities and is valid for five (5) years from the moment of signing. Either Party may terminate the agreement by written notification to the other Party not later than six (6) months before the termination of relations.

Article 5

- 1. When carrying out the activities within the framework of the present agreement, the Parties should consider the legislation of the Republic of Poland and the Republic of Estonia. In the event of a dispute, the Parties agree to exercise neutral jurisdiction.
- 2. Disputes arising under this agreement shall be resolved through discussions and negotiations between the Parties.
- 3. The agreement is drawn up in two (2) identical copies in English.
